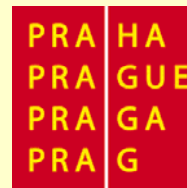

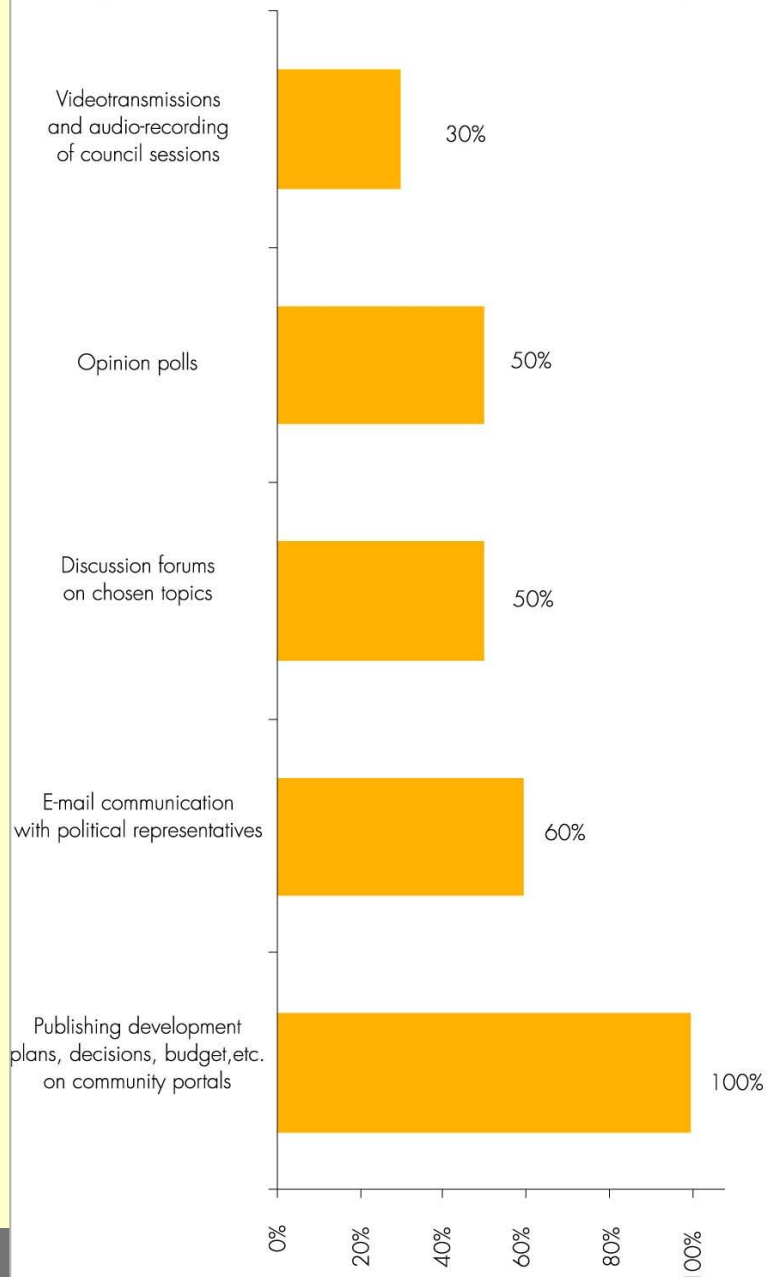
LEVEL OF eSERVICES FOR CITIZENS



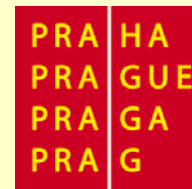
